



DAY 01: MUMBAI

Arrive in Mumbai, meet and greet at the airport, sightseeing in Mumbai, the gate of India, cave temples at Elephanta Island, CST railway station, high court, and the buildings of the colonial era.

DAY 02: MUMBAI - DIU - 1 HRS FLIGHT

Visit the Prince of Wales museum, and marine drive while heading to the airport to catch a flight for Diu.

DAY 03: DIU - SASAN GIR - 3 HRS DRIVE

Visit the fort of Diu built by the Portuguese colonizers in the 15th century later drive for Sasan Gir, the famous park of Asiatic lions in India.

DAY 04: GONDAL - 5 HRS DRIVE

In the morning safari in the national park then transfer to Gondal, once the seat of a famous Maharaja. In the afternoon walk in the town to enjoy the colorful life of Gujrat. Explore the streets full of colorful shops that sell textile of vibrant colors, Ethnic jewellery, and local artworks.



DAY 05: DASADA - 5 HRS

Morning drive to Dasada. In the afternoon safari in the semi desertic area called the Rann of Kutch. Enjoy the local flora and fauna which includes the Asiatic wild asses.

DAY 06: UDAIPUR - 6 HRS DRIVE

Drive to Udaipur. In the afternoon a walk through the old city called also the white city for its old building painted in white color. Walk around lake Pichola, Chand pol and clock tower area, and spice market.

DAY 07: UDAIPUR

In the morning visit the royal palace of Maharaja, one of the biggest palaces of India, and Jagdish temple which built-in 1650, later a boat ride on Lake Pichola to enjoy the beautiful panorama of the city. Evening enjoys traditional dance shows and lake view dinner.

DAY 08 : JAWAI VIA RANAKPUR - 3 HRS DRIVE

Drive to Jawai via Ranakpur the world-famous Jain temple, a masterpiece created in white marble. In the afternoon go for a safari in the Jawai area to spot the leopards and other animals and flamingos in the lake of Jawai. Overnight at luxury camps.

DAY 09: PUSHKAR - 5 HRS DRIVE

Drive to Pushkar, visit the holy town of Pushkar called also the king of Hindu pilgrimages for the only temple in India dedicated to the god of creation Lord Brahma. Walk around the lake of Pushkar, a colorful bazaar, and visit the Brahma temple.

DAY 10: JAIPUR - 3 HRS

Drive Jaipur, the pink city and capital of Rajasthan, an old city tour in the later afternoon.

DAY 11 : JAIPUR

In the morning visit of the amber fort. One reaches the fort riding an elephant. In the afternoon visit the beautiful palace of Maharaja, the astronomical observatory Jantar Mantar and the famous palace of winds.

DAY 12: RANTHAMBORE - 3.5 HRS DRIVE

Transfer to Ranthambhore. On the way visit of some rural villages to enjoy the countryside life of the most colorful state of India. In the afternoon a safari in the national park to spot the tiger and other animals and birds.

DAY 13: JAIPUR - MUMBAI - HOME

Drive back to Jaipur to catch flight to Mumbai then back home.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

If the Client wants to cancel the tour, he must intimate the Company in writing mailed to us at our office address on working days within office time. If the Booking Form has been signed by one or -more persons for themselves and for others mentioned in the form, communication signed by such signatories would be treated as valid communication for cancellation for all such persons mentioned in the form. The computation of the period of notice of cancellation shall commence only from the time the written request reached the Company at its office on working days within office time.

In addition to the above, in case of cancellation of the tour by either party, the amount spent by the Company on visas, medical insurance, POE, flight including administrative charges would be payable by the Client. If the total cancellation charges mentioned above exceed the amount paid by the Client, the balance amount would be payable by the Client.

In the case of Third-Party Products, the rules relating to cancellation and the cancellation schedule prescribed by the concerned Third Party Service Provider would be applicable and in addition, the Company shall have the right to claim service and communication charges. It is a clear understanding between the parties that for the purpose of this clause cancellation can be due to any reason whatsoever including the reason of inability to participate due to any reason including illness, death, court orders, non-availability of travel documents, etc.

Cancellation charges will be effective from the date we receive advice in writing, and cancellation charges would be as follows:

- 30 days prior to arrival: 25% of the Tour/service cost
- 15 days prior to arrival: 50% of the Tour/service cost
- 07 days prior to arrival or No show: 100% of the Tour/service cost
- (25 Dec from Christmas – 05 Jan bookings as well as Diwali festival trips will be nonrefundable)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

QUOTE, RATES & VARIATIONS

Our quotation system accesses both live pricing and static pricing depending upon the supplier. It is not uncommon for suppliers (e.g. Airlines, Cruise Liners and Hotels) to sell out, alter or withdraw prices including advertised special rates. If prices, rates or inclusions vary from your quotation or from an advertised price, we will advise you of any change prior to your booking request and any transaction being processed. If you do not wish to proceed with the booking at the new price, you may cancel the booking request at no cost to you. Once your booking has been confirmed and payment received, any new specials released cannot be applied to existing bookings. Prior to full and final payment being received, we reserve the right to vary prices and rates in the event of changes in exchange rates or price rises made by wholesalers or other suppliers. If the cost of any service increases due to exchange rate fluctuations, price increases, tax changes or any other reason, you are required to pay the increase when notified by us or you may cancel the booking. We are not liable in any way if any increase occurs due to exchange rate fluctuations, taxes or supplier notifications. Rates quoted are appropriate to the particular product at the time of quoting and these rates may change prior to the travel date. All prices are subject to availability and can be withdrawn or varied without notice.

PAYMENT & DEPOSIT

Our Bookings traveling more than 45 days out will be required to pay a deposit of 50 % at the time of confirmation sent and with the balance owing payable 30 days prior to travel (the "due date"). Prior to the due date, the balance owing may be paid by credit card, debit card or you may transfer into our bank account directly to avoid card fees. We will email you a final payment reminder. Travel vouchers and booking confirmations cannot be issued until final payment is received. If you fail to pay by the due date we reserve the right to automatically charge the credit card provided to complete the final payment. Any booking not paid in full by the due date is subject to automatic cancellation without further notification. Any deposit paid will be forfeited or, at your request, it may be used as a payment towards an alternative booking. Deposit conditions for certain accommodation and tour products may vary and we will advise you of these conditions and request your consent prior to proceeding with the booking. Bookings over Christmas and New Year's (Festive Season) require a non-refundable deposit of 25 % while confirmation of trip and final payment 60 days prior, as this is nonrefundable under any circumstances. We will refund this 25 % in case the tour is nonoperational or not confirmed dates. We highly recommend you purchase travel insurance if you are visiting India. Payment or deposit charges would be as follows:

- 10 % token amount for this trip (This amount is fully refundable if trip not confirmed)
- 50 % once all bookings / services are confirmed by us via email or status chart.
- Due amount will be paid 30 days before trip commenced or as per due date on invoice whichever is earlier.
